"To enrich students' lives, the community in which they live and the University of Surrey by creating the changes they want and to enable them to achieve their ambitions."


welcome

Our official name is the **University of Surrey Students' Union**, however our friends call us the *Students' Union*, the *Union* or sometimes just the *SU*. We are a **registered charity** and our job is to listen and act on behalf of the students of the University of Surrey. We work in a building on Stag Hill Campus, which is *also* referred to as the *Students' Union* or occasionally by our nightclub's name. *Rubix*.

It is important to note that - we are not a University department. We have a positive working relationship with the University and they assist us financially, however we operate independently from the University, allowing us to voice students' opinion openly, without a conflict of interest.

To make sure the Union only makes decisions with students' best interests at heart, **we employ five students to run the organisation**. Read on to find out more about what they do...

VP Community [Sabbatical]

Community Zone Committee [PT]

The Students' Union is led by a team of elected student officers. Some officer roles are full-time, paid positions; others are part-time voluntary roles.

The Students' Union has five full-time officers known as 'Sabbaticals' — The President and four Vice Presidents. While the President leads the strategic direction of the Union, the four Vice Presidents each lead a 'Zone Committee' for the four key areas of the Union - Voice, Support, Community and Activity. There are five elected student volunteer roles on each of the Zone Committees. The Union also elects a standalone voluntary role of Union Chairperson.

Glossary

Sabbatical - This is an elected officer position, in which a student takes a year out from their studies (or immediately after) to lead and work in the Union.

VP - Abbreviation for Vice-President.
[PT] - Abbreviation for Part Time . These positions are elected officer positions in which a student volunteers in the Union for a year alongside their studies.

THE ZONES

The Union operates under five 'Zones'. Each Zone takes responsibility for a different facet of student life, that has an impact on the student experience.

Union President

The Union President is the lead representative of the Students' Union. This position is a combination of all four Zones and being the leader involves grasping important student issues, managing the Vice-Presidents, managing the Students' Union CEO, Chairing the Students' Union Board of Trustees and having a vision for the organisation. The President is also a trustee of the University, making this officer a voting member of University Council.

Union Chairperson

The Union Chair is the only full-time student that is a trustee of the Union and a part-time officer. This officer chairs the Union Executive Committee (Exec) and is the lead student representative — responsible for leading the conversation, holding elected officers to account and upholding the Union's byelaws and policies.

Vice-President Voice

The Vice-President Voice (VP Voice) is the officer who takes responsibility for keeping democracy at the heart of the Students' Union, working on student surveys and feedback, supporting student-led change campaigns and maintaining our relationship with other Students' Unions nationwide. They also oversee our team of over 550 Course Reps who keep the Union informed of how programmes are being run and whether the cohort is happy.

Course Reps and Elections

Course Reps are elected student representatives who provide an essential link between those studying on a course and the staff delivering it. Every course has a Course Rep, to ensure vital feedback, direct from the cohort, is listened to and where necessary acted upon. As well as supporting the Course Reps, the Voice Zone is also responsible for running the Students' Union elections.

Vice-President Activity

The Vice-President Activity (VP Activity) is the officer who leads on encouraging students to get involved in something extra-curricular of their studies, for their personal growth and individual development as well as helping to break down barriers to activity. This can take the form of joining a sports club, a society, attending one of our Give it a Go trips or participating in social sport opportunities both on campus and at Surrey Sports Park.

Sports Clubs and Societies

The Activity Zone takes the leading role in student participation at Surrey and with over 5,000 Sports Club and Society members, they are doing a great job. The Zone supports more than 150 Sports Clubs and Societies, who cater for a wide variety of interests and pursuits, with new groups being created all the time. The Activity Zone is also responsible for helping students to develop as an individual, so expect to see events and activities throughout the year, helping students to learn new skills, improve existing ones or just have fun!

Vice-President Support

The Vice-President Support (VP Support) is the officer who leads on awareness campaigns, services which the Union provides to help students, and works full-time to represent the Union to those who provide support services to students. They also work with University Support services to provide feedback and suggested improvements.

Support and Academic Appeals

The Support Zone is here to help students with any issues, difficulties or challenges you may face during your time at University. Most of these can be directed straight to the VP Support, however sometimes they will need to come and speak to one of our dedicated caseworkers. These specially trained members of staff can talk them through any University academic appeal, complaint, extenuating circumstances, academic misconduct or disciplinary. So whatever a a student encounters during their time at Surrey, there is a friendly, helpful, person, ready to assist!

Vice-President Community

The Vice-President Community (VP Community) is the lead officer for social activity & events that bring students together, and representing the views of students within the campus community and the local community. The Community Zone works closely with external groups and Community Reps to manage and develop the Students' Union's relationship with residents, businesses and other relevant groups outside the University. Volunteering also sits within the Community Zone and our body of enthusiastic and dedicated volunteers engage in a wide variety of activities, helping them to gain new skills and meet other students.

The Union Executive (Exec) is the top student decision making body in the Students' Union.

The voting members of Exec are the Union President, Union Chairperson, VP Voice, VP Activity, VP Support, VP Community, plus two members from each Zone Committee.

(In the case of the Activity Zone, the Team Surrey Chair and Societies Chair are the positions that sit on Exec.)

Any student can attend Exec and submit a motion to make a change, for consideration by the committee.


