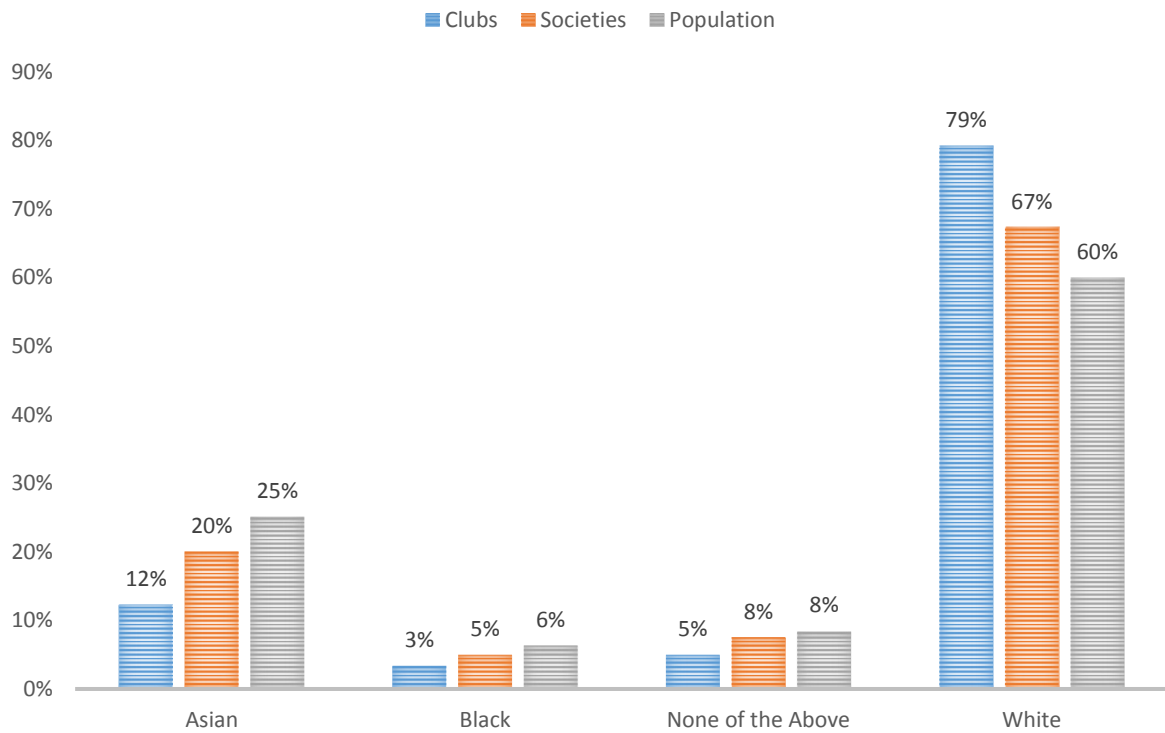

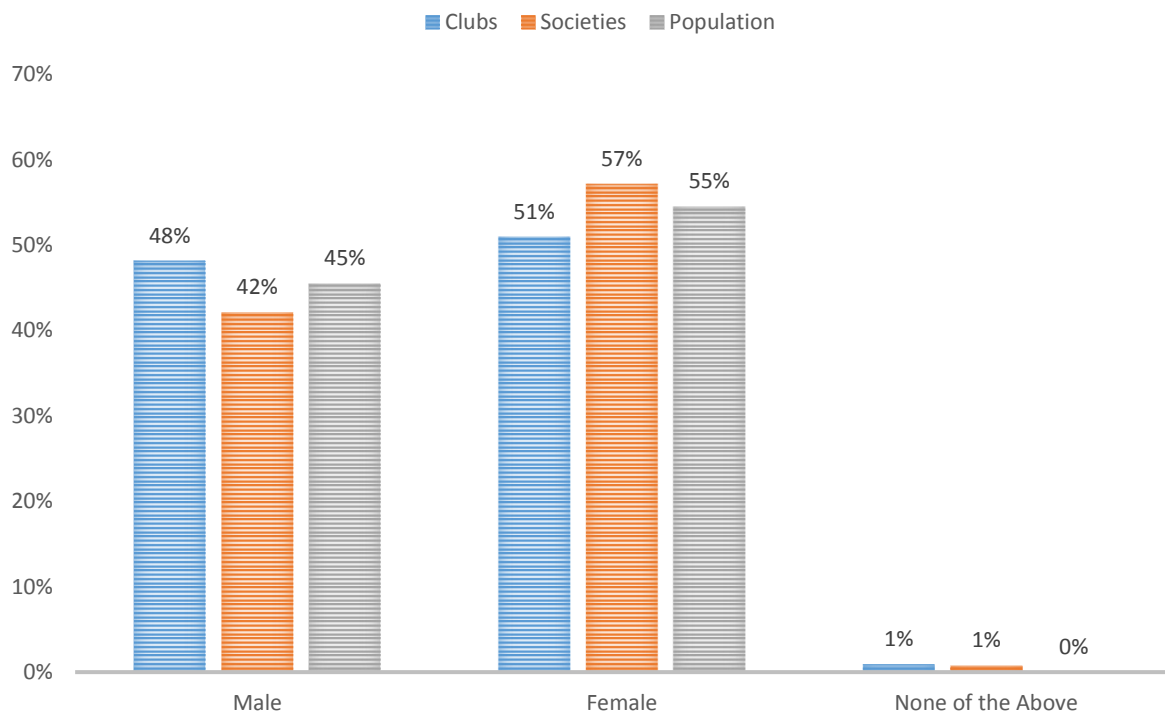

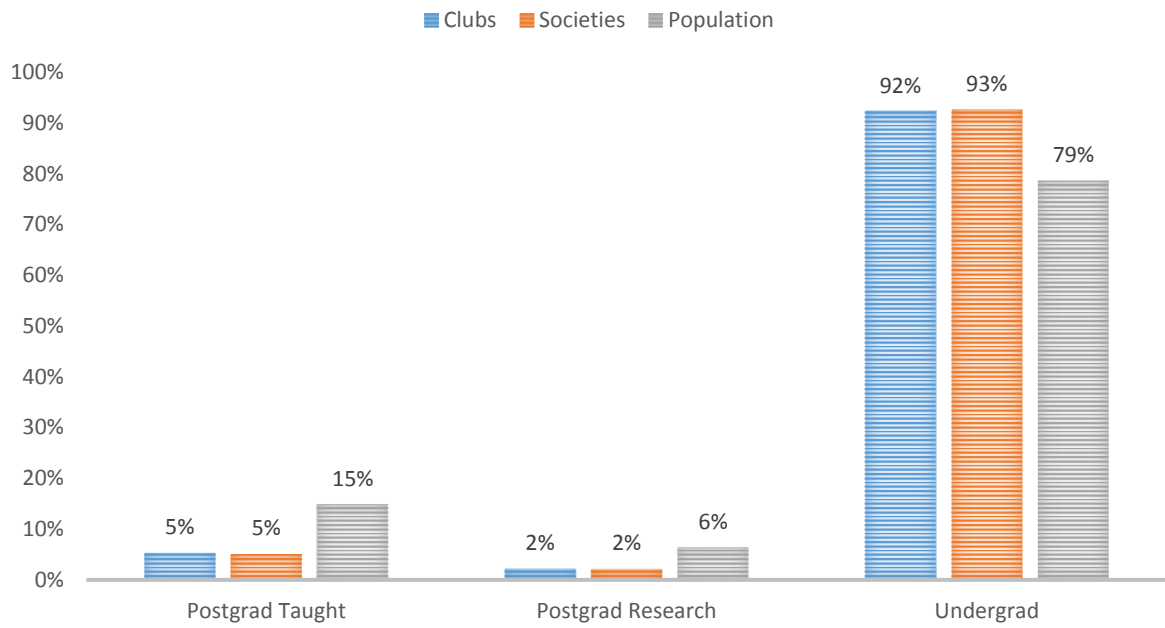
QUESTION 1. WHAT IS YOUR ETHNICITY?



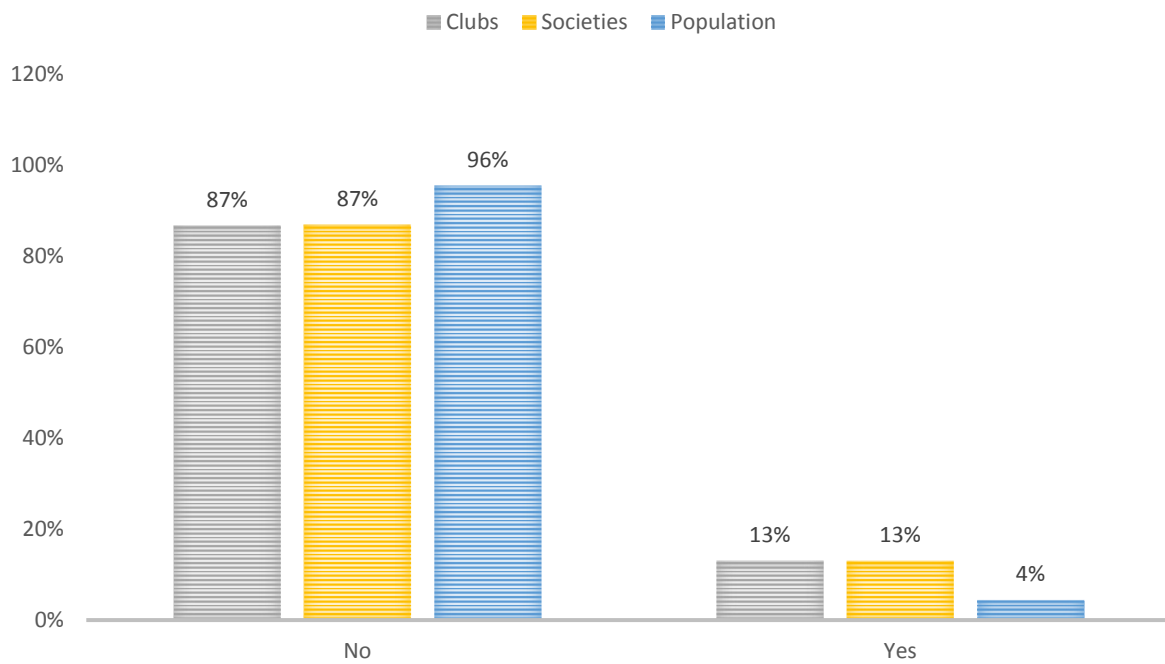
QUESTION 2. WHAT GENDER ARE YOU?



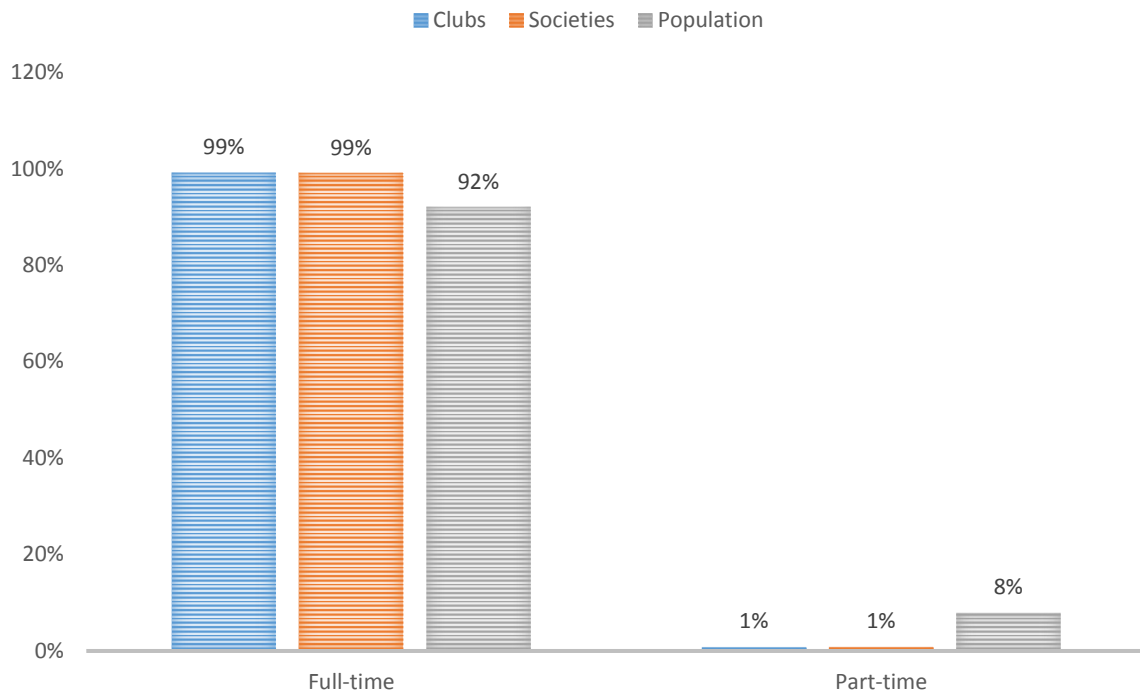
QUESTION 3. WHAT PROGRAMME ARE YOU ON?



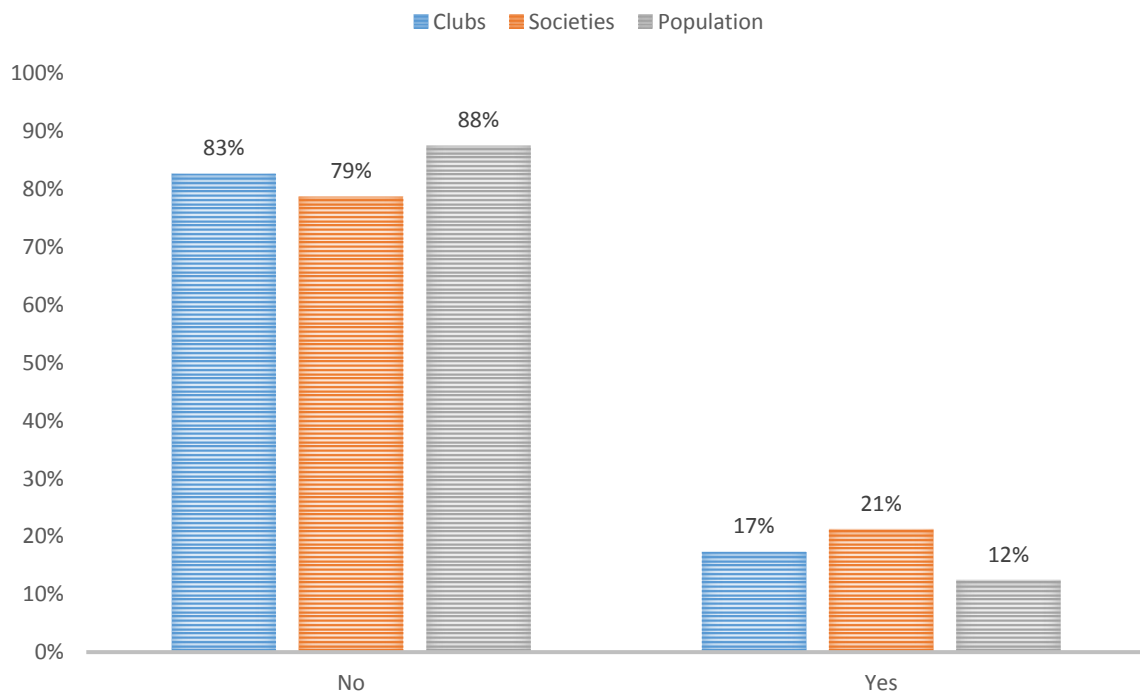
QUESTION 4. DO YOU RECEIVE A BURSARY?



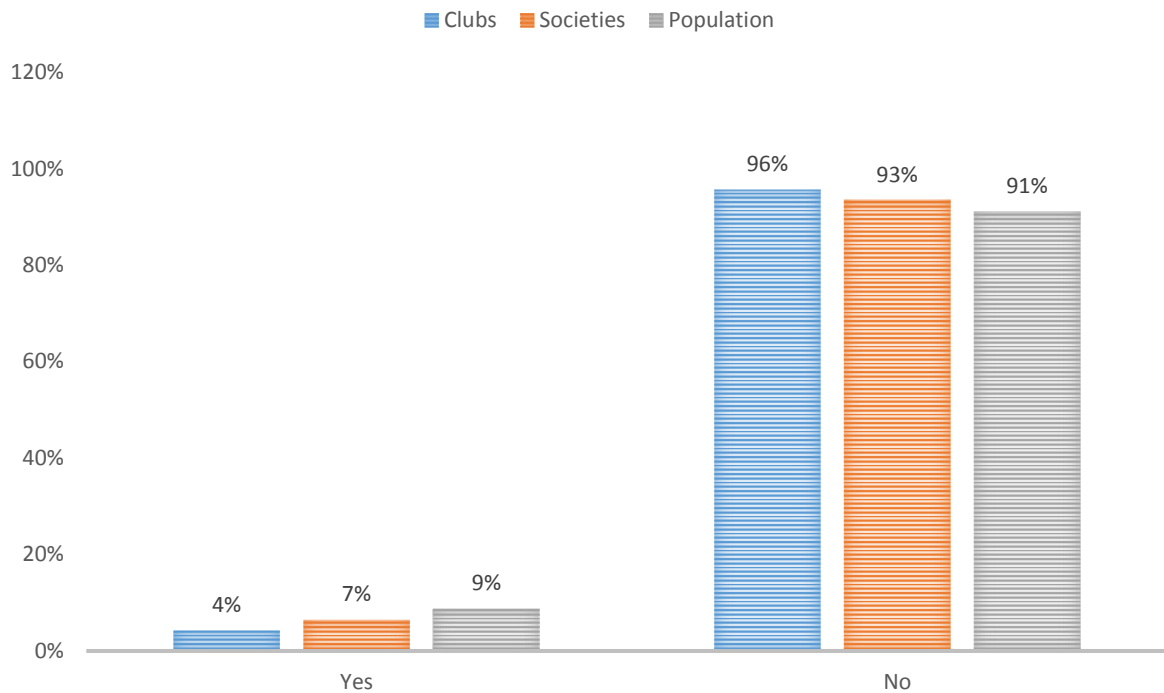
QUESTION 5. WHAT IS YOUR MODE OF ATTENDANCE?

QUESTION 7. DO YOU CONSIDER YOURSELF TO HAVE A DISABILITY?

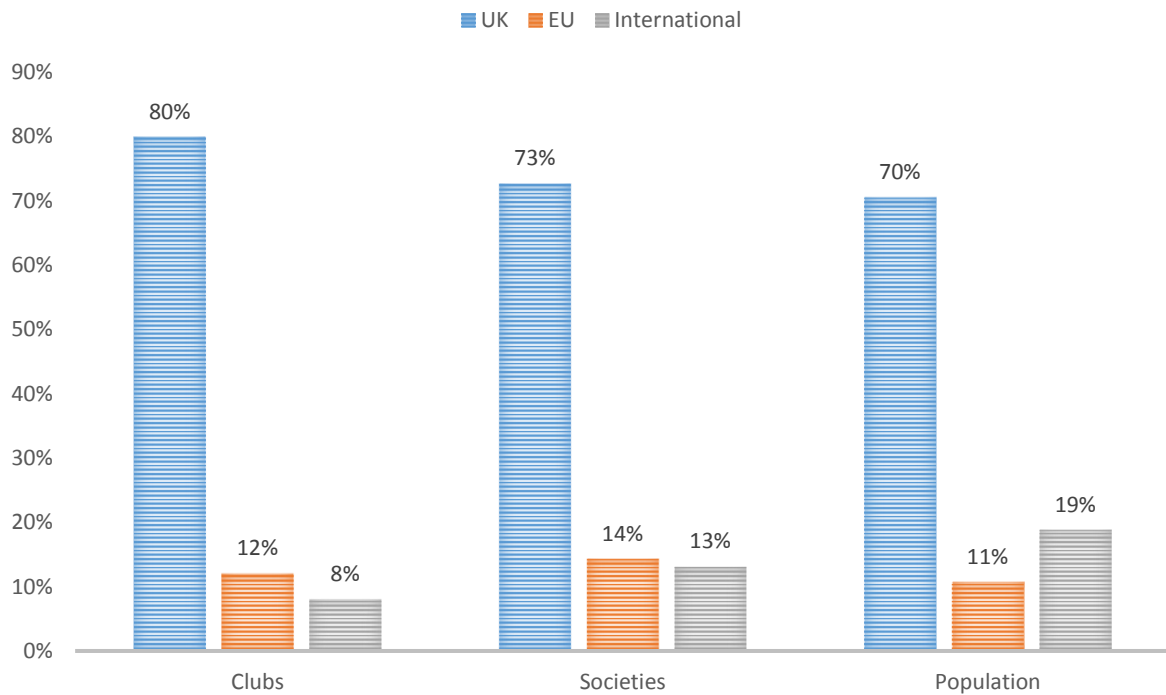


QUESTION 8. WHAT IS YOUR ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME?

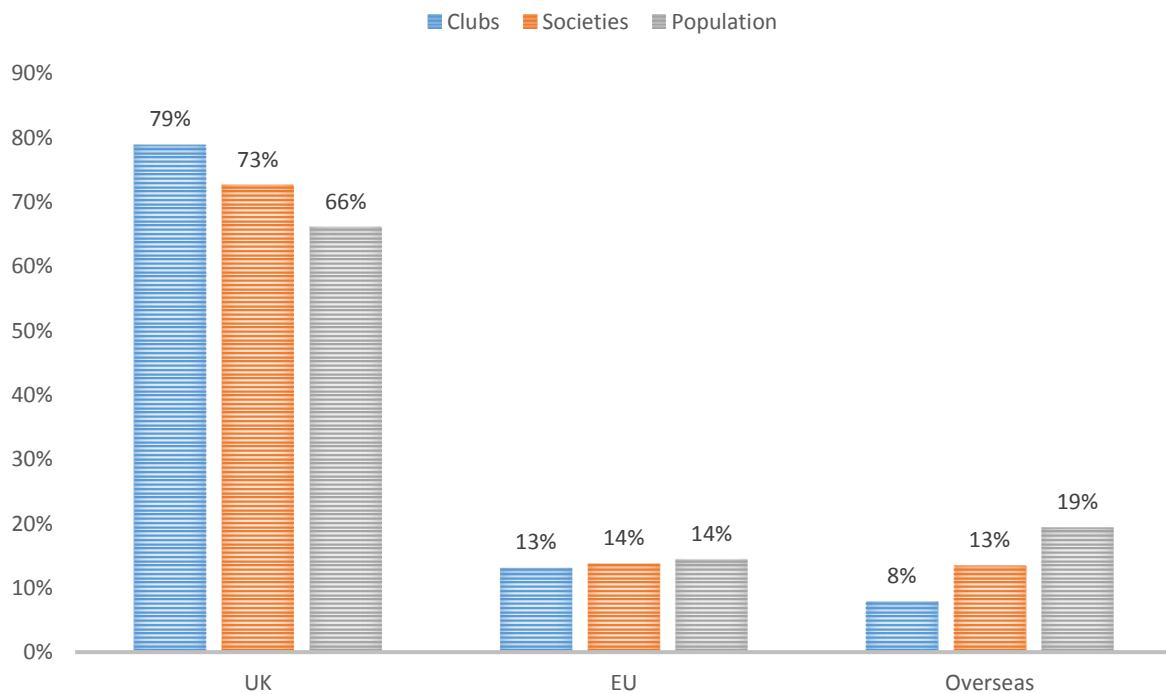
